

Who Is Jesus Christ?

Jesus is God

Jesus said “I and the Father are one” (John 10:30).

Notice that he did not claim to be a good moral teacher, as some people believe.

Jesus is the Savior

The Bible clearly says that all of us sin against God. “All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way” (Isaiah 53:6). In the New Testament it says “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23).

Our sin separates us from God and condemns us to hell. However, the great News is God, in His rich mercy and grace, provided the way for us to be reconciled to Him in and receive eternal life with Him. The Bible says “that Christ Jesus died for our sins” (1 Corinthians 15:3). It also says “for Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God” (1 Peter 3:18).

Jesus is the Only Way

Jesus also makes the assertion that He is the only Savior when He says “I am the way, the truth and the life; no one comes to the Father (God) except through me.” Jesus did not claim to be one of several ways to be reconciled to God; He claimed to be the only way.

In Romans 10:9 we read “if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.” It is not enough to believe the facts about Jesus’ life on earth some 2,000 years ago. Even Satan and his demons believe in the true God (James 2:19). They don’t love and obey Him. Their faith is not genuine. True saving Faith responds in obedience.

Jesus is the living God, the Savior, and the Only Way. Who do you say Jesus is? That is the question of life for all of us. He alone can free you from the power and penalty of sin, restore you to fellowship with God, and give you eternal life.
